

## **MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION MEETING**

**December 7, 2016**

The Williamson County Highway Commission met on Wednesday, December 7, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department facility at 302 Beasley Drive in Franklin, TN. Commission members present: County Mayor and Highway Commission Chairman, Rogers Anderson; Commissioners Stan Tyson, Wayne Davis, and Charlie Bennett. Commissioner Dick Fowlkes arrived after the votes were taken.

Chair Anderson called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m. and asked for the approval of the minutes of the November 2, 2016 Highway Commission meeting. Commissioner Tyson moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Bennett. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**1. Resolution 11-16-3 RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ROADS IN SILVERSTREAM, SECTION 4A AS A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE BY THE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LOCATED OFF ROCKY FORK ROAD. (HC Fowlkes; CC District 5, Green/Little).**

Superintendent Hood and Staff recommend approval. Commissioner Bennett moved for acceptance of the roads in Silverstream Subdivision, Section 4A. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**1. Highway Bid. (Leslie Mitchell/Greg Boll).**

Mrs. Mitchell and Superintendent Hood recommend acceptance of the low bid submitted by Neely Coble for a new water truck. Commissioner Bennett moved to accept the low bid submitted by Neely Coble. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

### **Highway Commission District Reports:**

**Commissioner Davis:** Commissioner Davis was not aware of any road issues to report. He invited everyone out for the Leipers Fork Christmas Parade on Saturday December 10<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m.

**Commissioner Fowlkes:** He was not aware of any road issues to report.

**Commissioner Tyson:** Commissioner Tyson stated that he received accolades from his constituents regarding the newly paved strips on Sneed Road as well as the cleaning out from under the Sneed Road Bridge.

**Commissioner Bennett:** He was not aware of any road issues to report.

**Highway Superintendent Report:** Superintendent Hood acknowledged the November Activity Report and reported that the department has a lot going on with milling and paving on Ash Hill Road, and with Patterson Road, Arno-College Grove Road, and Flat Creek Road bridge projects.


