

**MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION MEETING**  
**November 2, 2016**

The Williamson County Highway Commission met on Wednesday, November 2, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department facility at 302 Beasley Drive in Franklin, TN. Commission members present: County Mayor and Highway Commission Chairman, Rogers Anderson; Commissioners Stan Tyson, Wayne Davis, Charlie Bennett, and Dick Fowlkes.

Also present were: Eddie Hood, Highway Superintendent; Greg Boll, Elaine Vasquez, Randy Hickman, Highway Department; Joe Home, Community Development Director; William Andrews, Floyd Heflin, Engineering; Robert Cook, County Attorney, Buerger, Moseley, & Carson; and other interested individuals.

Chair Anderson called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m. and asked for the approval of the minutes of the October 5, 2016 Highway Commission meeting. Commissioner Tyson moved for approval of the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Bennett. The motion passed unanimously, 5-0.

**Special Announcements:** Chairman Anderson stated that a public meeting will be held on November 16, 2016 at the Page High School Auditorium from 6:00-7:30 p.m. He added that Superintendent Hood and Chad Collier will be addressing improvements to Arno Road based on the recommendations presented in the Major Corridor Study.

Superintendent Hood stated that a sign will be placed in front of Page High School to notify residents in the area about the meeting. He also stated that a Public Notice will be placed in The Tennessean newspaper.

Chairman Anderson stated that another public meeting will be held at a future date in the Grassland area.

**Citizen Communications:** There were no Citizen Communications.

**Elections and Appointments:** There were no Elections and Appointments.

**OLD BUSINESS:** There was no Old Business.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **Request from Tally Blair, on behalf of Ragnar Relay, for approval to utilize public roads within the jurisdiction of Williamson County, which are more specifically described in the attached maps, to conduct a charitable fundraising relay event on March 24 and 25, 2017. (HC Fowlkes/Bennett/Tyson; CC District 4, Danner/Lawrence; District 5, Green/Little; District 7, Chalfont/Bain; District 8, Walton/Sturgeon; District 9, Kaestner/Clark; District 12, Smith/Ausbrooks).**

Superintendent Hood recommended approval.

County Attorney Cook stated that all paperwork is in order.

Commissioner Tyson moved for approval of the request to utilize County roads in the Ragnar Relay. It was seconded by Commissioner Davis and passed unanimously, 5-0.

2. **Jaime Reed of SEC, Inc. presenting road improvement plans to Lampkins Bridge Road for Lampkins Crossing Subdivision. (HC Fowlkes; CC District 5, Green/Little).**

Mr. Reed withdrew the road improvement plan and stated that there are pending items that need to be addressed before seeking approval from the Highway Commission.

3. **REPORT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF CECIL LEWIS DRIVE, LORENA COURT AND LORENA DRIVE, AS A PART OF THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM. (HC Fowlkes; CC District 4, Danner/Lawrence).**

Superintendent Hood and Staff recommend acceptance.

Commissioner Fowlkes moved to accept the Report for Acceptance of the aforementioned subdivision roads. It was seconded by Commissioner Bennett and passed unanimously, 5-0.

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4. **Resolution 11-16-2 RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ROADS IN ADDITIONS TO BRIENZ VALLEY, SECTION TWO AS A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE BY THE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LOCATED OFF LEWISBURG PIKE. (HC Bennett; CC District 2, Herbert/Hester).**

Superintendent Hood and Staff recommend approval.

Commissioner Bennett moved for approval of Resolution 11-16-2. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 5-0.

5. **Resolution 11-16-3 RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ROADS IN SILVERSTREAM, SECTION 4A AS A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE BY THE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LOCATED OFF ROCKY FORK ROAD. (HC Fowlkes; CC District 5, Green/Little).**

Mr. Heflin withdrew Resolution 11-16-3 stating that an issue with the sidewalks will need to be addressed before approval.

6. **Resolution 11-16-4 RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ROADS IN ADDITIONS TO BRIENZ VALLEY, SECTION ONE AS A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE BY THE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LOCATED OFF LEWISBURG PIKE. (HC Bennett; CC District 2, Herbert/Hester).**

Superintendent Hood and Staff recommend approval.

Commissioner Bennett moved for approval of Resolution 11-16-4. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 5-0.

**Highway Commission District Reports**

**Commissioner Davis:** Commissioner Davis was not aware of any road issues to report.

**Commissioner Fowlkes:** Commissioner Fowlkes was not aware of any road issues to report.

**Commissioner Tyson:** Commissioner Tyson was not aware of any road issues to report.

**Commissioner Bennett:** Commissioner Bennett reported a problem in his area regarding the lookout on Pulltight Hill Road.

**Highway Superintendent Report:** Superintendent Hood stated that the citizens in the Pulltight Hill area presented him with a petition to close off the lookout on Pulltight Hill Road. He went on to say that there is an ongoing problem with graffiti and trash on the lookout. He stated that the Sheriff's Department is frequently called to the lookout, and that a fire on the hillside, and a suicide have been reported. He stated that he recommends closing the lookout by removing it altogether. Superintendent Hood added that removing the lookout will require the removal of a couple of beams, the removal of some asphalt, and replacing the asphalt with fill dirt. Superintendent Hood acknowledged the October Activity Report and stated that paving projects and bush hog operations are winding down just in time to gear up for winter weather.

**Highway Chairman Report:** Chairman Anderson had no further issues to present.

**Legal Issues:** County Attorney Cook had no legal issues to present
