

MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION MEETING

November 3, 2021

The Williamson County Highway Commission met on Wednesday, November 3, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department facility at 302 Beasley Drive in Franklin, TN. Commission members present: Wayne Davis, David Coleman, Stan Tyson and Charles Wilson. County Mayor and Highway Commission Chairman Rogers Anderson was unable to attend. Commissioner David Coleman chaired the meeting.

Also present were: Greg Boll, Elaine Vasquez, Brandon Wright, Highway Department; Joe Horne, Community Development Director; William Andrews, Engineering; County Commissioner Jerry Rainey, District 8; Robert Cook, County Attorney, Buerger, Moseley, and Carson, and other interested individuals. Superintendent Hood was unable to attend.

Commissioner Coleman called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m. and called for the approval of the minutes of the October 6, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Davis moved for approval of the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Wilson. The October 6, 2021 Highway Commission meeting minutes were approved unanimously, 4-0.

Commissioner Tyson requested that the minutes be amended to include an omitted statement he made at the October meeting.

Commissioner Tyson stated at the October meeting that applicants requesting permission to utilize County roads, State routes or roads in other jurisdictions for the purpose of holding a marathon, bicycle race, or similar event in the County should be required to seek approval to utilize those roads from the State or other jurisdiction as well as the County. County Attorney Cook stated that he will require applicants to do so.

Commissioner Tyson moved for approval of the October 6, 2021 meeting minutes as amended. It was seconded by Commissioner Davis. The motion to approve the October 6, 2021 meeting minutes as amended passed unanimously, 4-0.

Special Announcements: There were no Special Announcements.

Citizen Communications: County Commissioner Jerry Rainey, District 8, residing at 637 Beech Creek Road in Brentwood stated that he speaks today as a citizen and County Commissioner of the 8th District regarding the waterline that is to be installed by Harpeth Valley Utility District. Commissioner Rainey's concern is for the portion of the project scheduled for December where the waterline will cross Holly Tree Gap Road. He requested that it be delayed until spring and stated that Holly Tree Gap Road is a dangerous road, especially in inclement weather. He also requested Harpeth Valley Utility District to keep the public better informed of the plans for the project.

Elections and Appointments: There were no Elections and Appointments.

- 1. Request from Kevin Brian of Harpeth Valley Utility District to close a portion of Beech Creek Road near the Manley Lane intersection to install a 42 inch waterline. (HC Wilson; CC District 8, Sturgeon/Rainey).**

Sam Harrison of Harpeth Valley Utility District presented an overview of the project and requested permission to close a portion of Beech Creek Road on November 21st and 22nd. Jeff Seal presented the plans for construction on the project and stated that message boards will go up two weeks prior to the start of the project and that detour routes have been established. He also gave an overview of the plan to repair the road after the waterline has been installed and stated that the project will take place over a two day period when schools are out for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

Mr. Boll stated that Superintendent Hood is satisfied with the road repair plans and with the closure of Beech Creek Road on November 21st and 22nd.

Commissioner Coleman moved to grant permission for the closure of Beech Creek Road on November 21st and 22nd. It was seconded by Commissioner Wilson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

Commissioner Tyson requested a timeline for the entire project when Mr. Harrison returns before the Commission.

(HC Wilson; CC District 4, Story/Lawrence).**

Mr. Boll, speaking on behalf of Superintendent Hood, recommended approval.
Staff recommended approval.

Commissioner Wilson moved for approval of Resolution 11-21-22. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

3. **Resolution 11-21-21 RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ROADS IN CLOVERCROFT PRESERVE SUBDIVISION, SECTION TWO, AS A PART OF THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE BY THE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LOCATED OFF CLOVERCROFT ROAD. (HC Wilson; CC District 4, Story/Lawrence; CC District 5, Little/Lothers).**

Mr. Boll stated that Superintendent Hood recommended approval. Staff recommended approval.

Commissioner Wilson Moved for approval of Resolution 11-21-21. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

Commissioner Tyson: Commissioner Tyson reported a letter he received from a Kingston Springs City Alderman asking the County to stripe a two mile section of Kingston Road. He asked Superintendent Hood to respond to the letter and to email him a copy of the response.

Commissioner Coleman: Commissioner Coleman reported a speeding issue in Indian Meadows Subdivision and requested that the Sheriff's Department patrol the area.

Commissioner Wilson: Commissioner Wilson had no road issues to report.

Commissioner Davis: Commissioner Davis had no road issues to report.


Highway Superintendent Report: Superintendent Hood was unable to attend.

Highway Chairman Report: Chairman Anderson was unable to attend.

Legal Issues: County Attorney Cook had no legal issues to address.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at approximately 9:15 a.m.
