

MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION MEETING

December 7, 2022

The Williamson County Highway Commission met on Wednesday, December 7, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department facility at 302 Beasley Drive in Franklin, TN. Commission members present: Stan Tyson, Wayne Davis, and David Coleman. County Mayor and Highway Commission Chairman Rogers Anderson and Charles Wilson were unable to attend.

Also present were: Eddie Hood, Highway Superintendent; Greg Boll, Elaine Vasquez, Brandon Wright, Highway Department; Joe Horne, Community Development Director; Floyd Heflin, William Andrews, Engineering; Phoebe Reilly, Budget Director; Leslie Mitchell, Purchasing Agent; Commissioner Mary Smith, District 5; Robert Cook, County Attorney, Buerger, Moseley, and Carson, and other interested individuals.

Commissioner Coleman called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m. and called for the approval of the minutes of the November 2, 2022 meeting. Commissioner Davis moved for approval of the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Tyson. The November 2, 2022 Highway Commission meeting minutes were approved unanimously, 3-0.

Superintendent Hood stated that all work will take place within the right of way and a cash bond is needed before a permit will be issued to work in the right of way.

Commissioner Tyson moved to approve the offsite road improvement plan on Williams Road at Summerlyn Park Development. It was seconded by Commissioner Davis and passed unanimously, 3-0.

Commissioner Tyson stated that there is no drop off on the 90 degree turn, and a guardrail would cause more damage in the event of an accident than no guardrail.

Superintendent Hood agreed with Commissioner Tyson and recommended signage that would make the 90 degree turn highly visible.


