



Rules and Regulations

1. ***A signed contract and completed insurance certificate must be in the Ag Expo Park's possession no less than 30 days prior to your event.***
2. Payment by your organization will be collected by a member of the Ag Expo Park's management team prior to the conclusion of your event.
3. ***NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*** on the premises at any time. Failure to comply will result in notifying the Williamson County Sheriff's Office, and future events may be canceled.
4. ***NO SMOKING*** in any building, rest room, or stall barn area.
5. Skateboards, bicycles, skates, and scooters are not allowed in the main arena at any time.
6. ***Parking is NOT ALLOWED*** at the building's main entrance, or in any restricted area unless the vehicle has the proper permit (handicap). All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas. If a vehicle is illegally parked, it is subject to being towed.
7. ***NO load in or load out through any glass doors, please use roll up doors only.***
8. Only licensed vehicles with licensed operators will be permitted on roadways. Golf carts and mopeds are permitted if operated in a safe manner by licensed drivers. Motorcycles and four-wheelers will not be permitted.
9. Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are ***NOT*** allowed in stall areas.
10. Show management is responsible for verifying a current negative ***Coggins*** status per State law for ***EVERY HORSE*** on the grounds associated with their event.
11. ***NO*** glass containers, bottles, etc. will be allowed anywhere on the grounds for any reason.
12. Livestock will not be permitted in any landscaped areas.
13. ***Food vendors*** are ***not*** allowed unless pre-approved by Ag Expo Park management.
14. ***Dogs (pets) are PROHIBITED in the main arena and all areas contained within.*** Dog Shows are exempt, but access remains restricted in the main lobby. Service Animals are allowed.
15. No Burning Candles
16. Pine Needles are not allowed within any Ag Expo Park building.
17. Pyrotechnic displays, and tents must be permitted by the City of Franklin 615-791-3270
18. ***Food Vendors*** (more than 1 day) ***must be permitted*** and have their last inspection report available upon request. Health Permits can be secured through the vendor's local Health Department, or Williamson County Health Department @ 615-794-1542.



Franklin Fire Department Codes

- a. 8' (minimum) **aisle ways** must be maintained on mezzanine and arena floor levels
- b. 3' clearance around all **fire extinguishers**
- c. all **exit doors** (glass doors) must be clear of obstructions (no vendors in lobby).
- d. All **STROBES, EXIT SIGNS** and **EMERGENCY LIGHTING** must remain visible and clear of obstructions. **Pipe and Drape** must be 6' 6" or less on the mezzanine level....arena level pipe and drape is not restricted.
- e. Can NOT block aisle ways (stairs) to/from **seating areas**
- f. **Tents:** Must be flame resistant and permitted
- g. No Burning **Candles**
- h. Any **motor vehicle** parked inside the main building can have no more than 5 gallons of gasoline in it's tank, and must have a locking gas cap or cover. **Battery cable** must be disconnected.
- i. All **FIRE HYDRANTS** must remain accessible and free of obstructions.
- j. **Generators** must be inspected and permitted.
- k. Pine Needles are not allowed within any Ag Expo Park building.
- l. **Pyrotechnic Displays:** must be permitted

Your Event will be subject to fines and CANCELLATION if these conditions are not complied with and approved by the City of Franklin's Fire Department officials.

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Sign Ordinance

The Williamson County Ag Expo Park is now located within the City limits of Franklin. Therefore, if you are planning to place event signage on our grounds, or at the interstate access on Peytonsville Road you must conform to the City of Franklin's signage restrictions.

Basic Restrictions:

- * Commercial Sites: One double or 2 single faced signs not to exceed a total of 32 square feet (Example: One double faced 4' x 4' or two single faced 4' x 4' or one single faced 4' x 8').
 - *You must have approval from the Commercial Site owner, and sign can not be placed in the public right-of-way (approx.10 feet from road).
 - *Height restrictions: Can not exceed 6 feet as measured from the top of the sign to the ground below.
 - *Signs placed on residential property cannot exceed six square feet (e.g. 3' x 2') and cannot be located in the public right of way.
