### WCSO Deputy, Charity Honored with Award

A Williamson County Sheriff's Office Deputy and her favorite charity were honored with an award from Toyota of Cool Springs. Detective Sergeant Amy Cole was named Deputy of the Month for October.

She has worked for the WCSO for 18 years and is assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division.
