

IN THE JUVENILE COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE

VALID COURT ORDER

To _____, having appeared before the court on a status offense as defined in T.C.A. Code 37-1-102 (23) (a), you have been placed under a Valid Court Order.

You are hereby Ordered to do the following:

- Obey your parent's or custodian's requests, demands, or orders.
- Attend school each day and each class required unless you have an excused absence and obey all school rules.
- Obey all laws including those applicable only to juveniles.
- Obey all rules/conditions of Valid Court Order as established by your Judge or Referee.
- Obey all present and future orders of this court.
- Do not use or possess any illegal drug, paraphernalia, alcohol or tobacco products.
- Test negative on all court administered alcohol and drug screens.
- Do not possess or use guns, ammunition, knives and/ or other weapons.
- Pay all fines and costs.
- Perform all court ordered public service as directed by the Public Service Coordinator.
- You must report all arrests and citations to your Youth Service Officer.

Your failure to obey any one or more of these rules may result in a Violation of a Valid Court Order Petition and you may be held in a secure detention center.

**ORDER DIRECTING CHILD'S PARENTS/CUSTODIANS TO REPORT
VALID COURT ORDER, IN-HOME DETENTION AND PROBATION VIOLATIONS**

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that the above named child has been placed on County Probation, Valid Court Order and/or In-Home Detention Order and that such Valid Court Order, County Probation and/or In-Home Detention Order can only be successful with full cooperation of the child's parent or guardian;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the child's parents (or guardians/custodians) are hereby ORDERED to report all violations of the child's Valid Court Order, County Probation and/or In-Home Detention Order to the child's Youth Service Officer or Detention Staff immediately.

FAILURE TO REPORT such violations may result in the arrest of the parent {or guardian/custodian} and prosecution for **CRIMINAL CONTEMPT OF COURT**. The penalty for Contempt of Court can include up to ten (10) days in jail and a fine of up to fifty dollars (\$50.00).
