The Williamson County Regional Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing for the following item:

Concept Plan Review for High Park Hill Subdivision, located at Murfreesboro Road and referenced by Tax Map 109, Parcels 23 and 38, containing 157 lots on 161.03 acres. The request is being made by Sullivan Engineering, INC., P.O. Box 1708, Brentwood, TN 37024

The time allocated to each may speaker may be reduced based on the number of people wishing to speak.
