- I reside in a licensed facility, outside the county, providing relatively permanent domiciliary care (Nursing Home).
- I am hospitalized, ill or physically disabled and because of such condition, I am unable to appear at my polling place for this election OR I am a caretaker of person who is hospitalized, ill or physically disabled.
- I am a candidate.  I am on jury duty in a state or federal court.  I am serving as an election official.
- I have a Commercial Drivers License (or I am the spouse of the person who has a CDL) and will be out of county during the open hours of early voting & Election Day & I have no specific out-of-county or out-of-state address to receive mail during this time. - I am observing a religious holiday that prevents me from voting early or on Election Day.
- I have a valid Transportation Worker Identification Credential. (Must include a photocopy of valid TWIC).

**Absentee Ballot requests are processed and ballots are mailed to the voter in the order in which they are received by our office. Absentee ballot request may be received no earlier than ninety (90) days before Election day and no later than seven (7) days before Election Day. Ballots must be received by mail by the close of the polls on Election Day in order to be counted.**
