Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 13-7-104 and Section 13-7-105, notice is hereby given that this meeting will include a Public Hearing for an Amendment to the Williamson County Subdivision Regulations.

The time allocated to each speaker may be reduced based on the number of people wishing to speak.
